


New [LMS Learning Tracks](#)

We created new LMS learning tracks to help clinic staff better identify their roles and the required training best suited for their position.

- Site Certifier
 - The Medical Director, Physician, Certified Nurse Practitioner or Certified Nurse Midwife who is responsible for overseeing the family planning services at the site.
- Clinicians
 - Physicians and Non-Physician Medical Practitioners (NMPs) including Nurse Practitioners, Physician Assistants and Certified Nurse Midwives, who are NOT identified as the site certifier.
- Administrative
 - Medical Assistants (MAs) and Front Office Staff who certify clients for enrollment, deliver client education and counseling and manage medical records on behalf of the Family PACT Program.
