What is Family PACT?

Family Planning, Access, Care, and Treatment (Family PACT) is a program that provides family planning and reproductive health services at no cost to eligible Californians.

What services are covered?

- » All FDA-approved contraceptive methods and sterilization
- » Emergency contraception
- » Sexually transmitted infection (STI) testing and treatment
- » HIV testing and counseling
- » Cervical cancer screening
- » Management of urinary tract infections (UTIs)

Am I eligible?

Eligible individuals are those who:

- » Are residents of California
- » Have a medical need for family planning, meaning you can get pregnant or cause a pregnancy
- » Are at or below 200% of the federal poverty level
- » Have no other family planning coverage or have certain barriers to accessing that care

What if I don't want others to find out I'm using birth control?

Signing up for Family PACT is confidential, and so is the care you get.

This means that no one has to know about your family planning needs if you don't want them to.

Important: Family PACT is available to all eligible individuals regardless of immigration status.
